1. Definition

The GDPR imposes new obligations on organisations that control or process personal data and introduces new rights and protections for EU citizens.

- 6. Processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security of the personal data, including protection against unauthorised or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction or damage, using appropriate technical or organisational measures
